- The House schedule is basically arranged around fundraising. For example, Congressional committees never work through lunch, because that is key fundraising time.
- And legislators rush back to these rooms between afternoon votes and evening votes, to do even more fundraising, reading from telemarketing scripts.

This is a sad new reality for BOTH PARTIES, and for representatives in EVERY STATE. The average cost of a campaign is now upwards of \$1.3 million for a two-year term in Congress -- which means politicians are always in fundraising mode.
